Just an update on building repairs and upgrades. If you recall my letter back in June, I was looking for donations so that we could address some of the issues concerning the building. The roof has been altered in design and repaired. This should stop the build up of snow and ice that has caused all the water damage to the ceiling in the lobby and the carpeting. The roof and ceiling were repaired and painted at a cost of \$8100, thanks to **Bro. Furtney's** son's company, MKF Building and Remodeling Inc.

The downstairs dining hall walls have been cleaned of mildew and repainted. Cost \$147. This doesn't reflect all the man hours or money the officers have put into this and other projects.

Two new Aspen humidifiers have been installed downstairs - one in the dining hall and the other in the old supply room. Cost \$1173. We thank **Bro. Corsetti** for these.

It is still not too late if you wish to donate. We have only received a little over \$2000 from some of our members along with what our officers have donated in time and money.

A special thanks goes to **Bro. John Sinclair** for his support and donation.
